4 Day Sydney Stopover

Day 3. Blue Mountains, Koalas. This morning, tour the spectacular Blue Mountains and view the sandstone pillars of the Three Sisters. Perhaps ride aboard the Cableway or Scenic Railway (own expense). In the afternoon, visit an Australian wildlife park and perhaps have your photo taken with a cuddly koala (own expense). If you wish, you may replace the Blue Mountains tour with any other APT day tour (change can only be made once you are in Sydney).

Day 4. Depart Sydney. Enjoy the morning at leisure then transfer to Sydney airport for your onward flight.

4 Day Melbourne Stopover

Day 1. Melbourne. Be welcomed on arrival and transferred to your hotel. Tonight is at leisure for you to explore the charms of this cosmopolitan city. Melbourne is famous for its multicultural flavour – choose one of the many fine restaurants and cafés to dine in.

Day 3. Great Ocean Road, Twelve Apostles, Loch Ard Gorge, London Bridge, Melbourne.

10 Day South East Highlights

Day 1. Sydney. Be welcomed on arrival in the harbour city of Sydney and transferred to your hotel. The remainder of the day is then yours at leisure to explore. This evening, you'll enjoy the opportunity to choose where you dine from one of the many restaurants within the city (own expense).

Enjoy a picnic lunch in a natural setting then journey to the north coast for further exploration of the island's amazing scenery and wildlife.

Stay: Kangaroo Island – Ozone Seafront Hotel (First-Class). FL

Day 10. Flinders Chase, Koalas, Fur Seals, Depart Adelaide.

Today see New Zealand fur seals in their colony at Cape du Couedic and discover the formation of the Remarkable Rocks. At Admirals Arch, see where the forces of nature have cut through the headland to create a unique geological formation. Admire the Cape du Couedic Lighthouse then, after lunch, search for koalas in their natural habitat. At dusk, watch for Tammar wallabies and kangaroos grazing out in the open. Then fly back to Adelaide (airfare included) this evening, where your Regional Mini Stay concludes on arrival. FL



Depart Adelaide by air, arriving on Kangaroo Island by 10.00 am. Meet your guide for an introduction to Kangaroo Island before heading out in search of wildlife encounters. The first stop for the day is at the Eucalyptus Distillery. From here, travel to Seal Bay for a leisurely stroll on the beach among the rare and endangered Australian sea lion colony with your specially trained guide. Enter our exclusive Heritage-listed natural bush property to enjoy a gourmet picnic lunch with wine. Then visit the Kelly Hill Caves and see kangaroos and wallabies feeding at dusk in Kelly Hill Conservation Park, which is only accessed by special permit.

Stay: Kangaroo Island Wilderness Retreat. L

Day 2. Flinders Chase National Park, Remarkable Rocks, Admirals Arch, Fur Seals, North Coast, Stokes Bay.

This morning perhaps take a morning walk among unspoilt nature surrounding your accommodation. Then your guide will take you to Flinders Chase National Park to see the fur seals frolicking in the ocean at Cape Du Couedic and in the unique geological formation of Admirals Arch. Visit the Remarkable Rocks, then enjoy lunch among gum trees before travelling to the north coast to explore stunning beaches and walk on secretive bush tracks in search of the elusive Glossy Black cockatoo, kangaroos, wallabies and koalas. Stay: Selected First-Class or Standard accommodation. L

Day 3. Frenchman's Rock, Cape Willoughby.

Tour the eastern part of the island. Visit Frenchman's Rock and the visitor centre then travel to Cape Willoughby, the island's most easterly point, and join a ranger for a tour of the lighthouse. 2 Day Kangaroo Island Wilderness Discovery

This is your opportunity to discover Australia's famous wildlife icons on one island. This trip is perfect for those on a tight timeframe. See kangaroos, koalas, wallabies and sea lions in their natural habitat while travelling with top-class local guides who will introduce you to the land, people and spirit of Kangaroo Island.

Day 1. Adelaide, Kangaroo Island.

Be picked up at around 6 am from your Adelaide hotel and transfer to Cape Jervis for your ferry to the island. On arrival, meet your guide and travel via Penneshaw to glorious Pennington Bay. Enjoy an early picnic lunch at a secluded location, then head for Seal Bay to wander among the rare Australian Sea Lion colony. Then trek over the sand dunes of Little Sahara before arriving at the Kelly Hill Caves. Here, enjoy a guided tour, taking in the ornate calcite formations. Then continue your journey along the South Coast road, keeping an eye out for koalas in the wild. Tonight, after dinner, take the opportunity to look for nocturnal wildlife or swap stories under the starry skies.

Stay: Kangaroo Island Wilderness Retreat – twin share accommodation. LD

Day 2. Kangaroo Island to Adelaide.

This morning rise early and head for Flinders Chase National Park. Here, visit the magnificent formation of Admirals Arch and get up close with New Zealand Fur Seals as they frolic in the Southern Ocean. During May-September you may even spot Southern Right whales from this spectacular view point. After a short drive, visit the geological monuments of Remarkable Rocks, an incredible display of millions of years of wind and ocean weathering. Next stop is Rocky River Headquarters where you'll learn more about the island's habitat. After lunch, take a short wilderness trek on any one of three bushland trails, giving you the chance to take in the beautiful contrast between river and coastal scenery. Then head to one of the secluded beaches on the north coast of the island. Late in the day, you'll have further opportunity to view Kangaroos and Tammar wallabies as they come out to graze in the open fields. To conclude the day, enjoy the pelican feeding spectacle at Kingscote Wharf. Armed with the best photos of wildlife and scenery imaginable, head to your point of departure for your return back to Adelaide. BL

WALK WITH THE SEALS AT SEAL BAY

At Kangaroo Island's Seal Bay Conservation Park, you'll see Australian Sea Lions up close in their natural environment of coastal vegetation, dunes and beach. Watch in delight as these fascinating creatures nurture their young, jostle, play and rest on the beach after an exhausting few days feeding at sea – a little like watching a wildlife documentary unfold before your eyes.

NATIONAL PARKS – REMARKABLE

National and conservation parks cover more than one third of the total area of land on Kangaroo Island, declared in order to preserve the island's unique plant and wildlife species. Kangaroo Island's four major parks are Flinders Chase National Park, Kelly Hill Conservation Park, Seal Bay Conservation Park and Cape Willoughby Conservation Park, all of which you'll visit on this safari.
